

Chairman Larry Morse called the regular meeting of the Board to order at 8:00 p.m. Trustees Larry Morse, Mark Reed, Trustee John McMahan and Fiscal Officer Marie Rohrbaugh were also present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairman Larry Morse moved to approve the minutes as presented of the Board's regular meeting held on June 1, 2022, second by Trustee Mark Reed, 3 ayes, motion carried.

NAD: Trustee McMahan attended NAD's monthly meeting. No report was submitted.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR: The Fiscal Officer reported the Zoning Inspector's job opening was advertised in the Star Beacon and the qualifications and responsibilities were posted to the township website. No applications have been received, will accept applications until July 6, 2022 meeting. The Chairman reported photos of Gentry & Schlegeter properties must be dated and time stamped closer to the August 1, 2022 due date. The Chairman reported the Zoning Inspector is working on Boughner Road dog kennel living quarters.

ZONING COMMISSION: Next meeting June 20, 2022

BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS: No report.

TRUMBULL TOWNSHIP FIRE AND RESCUE: The Fire Chief reported Engine #253 2022-F250's faulty siren was repaired under warranty and received a recall regarding it's wipers. The Chief asked if any update on Austinburg's Joint Fire District meeting or on getting fuel tank? The Chairman reported the fuel tank from Centerra is still backordered.

ROAD AND BRIDGE: Trustee Reed reported ditching, tree trimming & cemetery work is on-going. The Board approved ordering 1,000 ton of #411 Limestone. The International Truck #1 is back from transmission repair costing \$4,859.16. The Board discussed purchasing a new cemetery mower next year.

OLD BUSINESS: Trustee McMahan reported new signage at SR 534 & SR 166. Road Department to make repairs to Old Town Hall when time is available. Mr. Belding can't help with repairing cemetery stones at this time. Trustee Reed suggested replacing broken cemetery stones with plaques. Trustee Reed reported light pole at SR 534 & SR 166 is First Energy's top priority in next week or two. Chairman Morse checking on lighting fixtures from JDT Electric, scheduling gutter installation and move things behind fire department.

NEW BUSINESS: Library spokesman, Michael Horton spoke on the library receiving a federal grant fund paying for the equipment and service to increase the areas internet bandwidths by installing a multilink router inside the township hall at no cost to the township creating a hot spot in the hall and parking lots. The Board discussed the Zoning Administrator be a township resident, review monthly salary, consider salaries of other townships, applications to be received until 8:30 p.m. on July 6, 2022, scheduling interviews. No decision was made.

FISCAL OFFICER REPORT: The Fiscal Officers' financial reports and document reflecting timely payment of Township bills were reviewed. Chairman Larry Morse moved to approve the Fiscal Officer's financial reports, seconded by Trustee Mark Reed, 3 ayes, motion carried. The Fiscal Officer presented the Resolution to Proceed for Road & Bridge Levy Renewal 3.0 mil expiring in tax year 2023 for the November 8, 2022 election stating its intention to proceed with ballot issue. Chairman Morse moved to proceed with submission to electors the 3.0 mil Road & Bridge Levy Renewal at the November 8, 2022 election, seconded by Trustee Mark Reed, 3 ayes, motion carried. Chairman Morse moved to authorize the Fiscal Officer to transmit to the Board of Elections all required documents regarding the renewal of Road & Bridge Levy, seconded by Trustee Mark Reed, 3 ayes, motion carried.

The Chairman opened the floor for comments from others in attendance who desired to speak. Sarah Hammers, and Paul Knauff commented on the Pohto's Variance Hearing schedule. Adam Niewiadomski showed interest in the Zoning Administrators position.

Chairman Larry Morse moved to adjourn the regular meeting, seconded by Trustee John McMahan, 3 ayes, motion carried.
